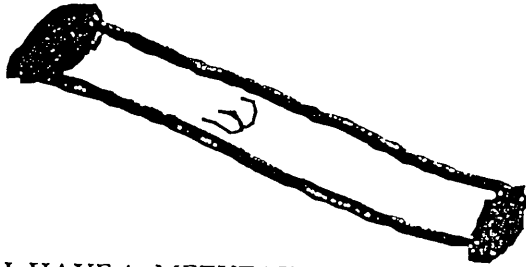
THE CURTAINS OF THE ARK
